Peak Season: December—April

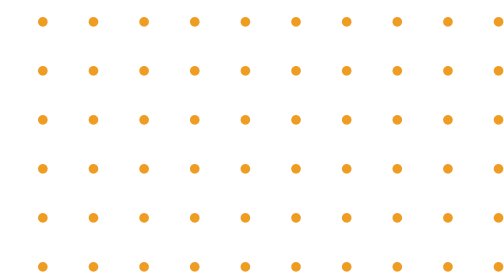
Dry weather, high demand, and premium pricing

Shoulder Season: Late April—June

Warm weather, fewer crowds, and better value

Off—Peak Season: September—October

Lowest prices, hotter temps, and rain potential

## HURRICANE SEASON

Hurricane season runs June — November, mainly impacting coastal areas. September tends to be the most active month. Flexible travelers often find great value during this time.

Semana Santa (Easter): Extremely crowded

Day of the Dead (Nov 1—2): Cultural and meaningful, but busy
