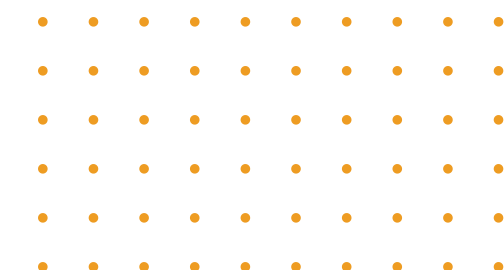


best times to travel **TO THE HAWAIIAN ISLANDS**

Peak Season: Mid June — August & late December
School breaks bring higher prices and crowds

Shoulder Season: April — early June & September
Excellent weather, fewer crowds, and better availability

Off—Peak Season: January—March (excluding holidays)
Cooler temps, higher surf, and good value for flexible travelers
