best times to travel TO THE CARIBBEAN

Peak Season: December—April

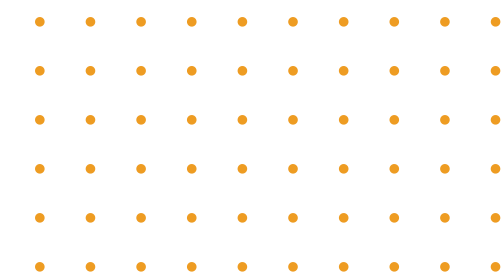
Dry weather, cooler temps, highest prices, busiest time of year

Shoulder Season: Late April—Early June

Warm weather, fewer crowds, better pricing — ideal balance

Off—Peak Season: Late August—October

Lowest prices, fewer travelers, but higher weather risk

HURRICANE SEASON

Hurricane season runs June 1–November 30, with the highest activity typically from August–October. Many travelers still enjoy beautiful trips during this time, but flexibility and travel protection are important.

HOLIDAYS & EVENTS

Christmas & New Year's: Extremely popular and expensive

Spring Break (March–April): Crowded and family-heavy
Carnival (varies by island): Festive and lively, but busy
